



Your school uniform confirms your attendance at the school and is a symbol of unity within the school community. It minimizes distractions in the learning process. You must take pride in your appearance by wearing your complete uniform, always remembering that by wearing it inside and outside the classroom and the school, you are representing the school. Your behavior should be a credit to both yourself and the school community.

Girls K - 5: Jumper, yellow GSS collar. During inclement weather, girls may wear blue uniform pants. Navy blue or white stockings. All black footwear. Black sneakers with colored designs or soles are prohibited.

Girls 6 - 8: Skirt, yellow GSS collar shirt. During inclement weather, girls may wear blue uniform pants. Navy blue or white stockings. All black footwear. Black sneakers with colored designs or soles are prohibited.

Boys K - 8 Navy dress uniform trousers (no corduroys or Dockers, or baggies), with a belt and yellow GSS collar shirts. All black footwear. Black sneakers with colored designs or soles are prohibited.

On the day the children have gym, they may wear their gym uniform to school. The gym uniform is navy blue school uniform shorts with the school's name, navy blue school tee-shirt, and sneakers. Students must wear sneakers on gym day.

Eighth Grade may wear their class sweatshirt. During the cold weather, students may wear the navy-blue uniform cardigan sweater. Students may not wear other types of sweaters or sweatshirts.

Masks are considered part of the uniform. Masks with political or anti-religious statements are prohibited.

Jewelry

- Boys wearing earrings or fashion necklaces to school is prohibited
- Girls may NOT wear large hoops or drop earrings. Simple earrings only may be worn.
- Diameter of hoop earring can be no larger than the circumference of a pinky finger

Chains and bracelets are to be simple and kept to a minimum.

Nails

- Long and painted nails are not permitted in school. Permissible length: the tip of the finger.
- Clear nail polish is allowed.

Hair

Boys and Girls are expected to keep clean, neat hairstyles at ALL times.

- Unconventional hairstyles are NOT allowed. These include, but are not limited to: spikes, Mohawks, or shaved designs.
- Unnatural hair dyes are NOT allowed.
- Boys are to wear their hair NO LONGER than the collar of their shirts.

Make-Up

- Make-up is NOT allowed.

Personal Appearance

A good personal hygiene routine should be followed daily: ears, neck, and fingernails should be given special attention. When appropriate, children should be instructed by their parents in the use of deodorant.

The uniform should be neat and clean. Hair should be clean and well-groomed. The boys' hair should not be below the shirt collar. Bangs should not be so long that they impede vision.

Parents will be notified if a child comes to school consistently in an unkempt manner. If no improvements are noticed within a reasonable amount of time, school officials will make an appointment with the parents and with the guidance counselor.
